I was never completely confused in the class because he never left room for confusion. We did so many problems that everyone seemed to follow with what was going on. He graded really well, I loved getting partial credit on my tests. I would recommend him to any student who is looking for a good teacher that gets straight to the point and does it well!

He is a great professor! He makes calculus interesting, which is very hard to do! He is always willing to help students, and even has review sessions the night before exams!

He made concepts easier for us to understand and made sure we had plenty of examples. The tests and quizzes were fair, however asking definitions of math ideas on the tests seemed impractical and irrelevant.

I felt like Phil was an excellent instructor. He knew the material well, and could explain it well to the students. He was available in office hours, and before every test gave a review session in the evening. I feel he was dedicated to the job and truly wanted his students to succeed. I have dropped calculus twice before because of the teacher being unreasonable. Prof. Bergonio was very enthusiastic about the material which made it much easier to understand. He assigned homework and administered quizzes that both proved to be beneficial for the test. Best math course thus far.

I have not taken math in 2 years so I was nervous about my competency in the class; however, he made the material very easy to comprehend and was very helpful during his study sessions before the tests. I also thought his method of grading was fair and effective.

I like that he used a good mix of book problems, outside problems, and worksheets in the classtime.
