I think that he did a great job of explaining the topics. He was helpful when you asked questions about homework. The only thing that bothered me was the difficulty of his tests.

I thought he was a good teacher. He was willing to help anyone that needed it. He held review sessions on nights before tests which were extremely helpful. My only two complaints are: 1) he needs to write bigger and more clearly on the board and 2) he had a habit of making simple mistakes and dwelling on those mistakes.

In the beginning of the semester he went way too fast. As one of the students who hadn't taken AP Calculus previously, I felt left behind. After the first test he started working at a better pace that was easier to keep up with. I really thought homework assignments were helpful as well as the review sessions. One thing is that he made tiny mistakes in class when doing a problem, but they were usually caught by another student or corrected. I guess that had the possibility of being confusing but all in all I enjoyed having him as a teacher.
